- **The Day of Remembrance for all Victims of Chemical Warfare** is an annual event held **November 30**
- **World AIDS Day** is observed across the world on **1st December** every year & the theme of 2021 is **End inequalities. End AIDS and End Pandemics**.
- The **Border Security Force (BSF)** is observing its **57th Raising Day** on 01 December 2021.
- **National Pollution Prevention Day or National Pollution Control Day** is observed across India on **2nd December** to memorialize the people who have lost their lives in the 1984 Bhopal Gas Calamity, which is also referred to as the **Bhopal gas tragedy or Bhopal disaster**.
- **World Computer Literacy Day** is observed on **2nd December** to create awareness about computers and to encourage the development of technological skills among people especially children and women in India.
- Every year, the **International Day for the Abolition of Slavery** is observed on **December 2** since **1986** by the **United Nations General Assembly** & the theme of 2021 International Day for the Abolition of Slavery is **Ending Slavery's Legacy of Racism: A Global Imperative for Justice**.
- **International Day of Persons with Disabilities** is an international observance on **December 3**

promoted by the United Nations since 1992 & the theme of the day is 'Leadership and participation of persons with disabilities toward an inclusive, accessible, and sustainable post-COVID-19 world' Every year.

- **Indian Navy Day** is observed annually on **4 December** to recognise the achievements and role of our naval forces & the theme of Indian Navy Day 2021 is 'Swarnim Vijay Varsh' signifying 50 years of India's victory in the Indo-Pakistan war that took place in 1971.
- The United Nations General Assembly decided to keep **December 4** as **International Day of Banks** and it was celebrated for the first time in 2020.
- **World Soil Day (WSD)** is held annually on **5 December** as a means to focus attention on the importance of healthy soil and to advocate for the sustainable management of soil resources. "Halt soil salinization, enhance soil production" is the theme for **World Soil Day 2021**

- The **Union government** has formed a **five-member committee** to ensure timely completion of various projects executed under the **Central Vista Redevelopment Plan & Former Finance Secretary Ratan P Watal** has been appointed the **Chairman** of the **five-member Central Vista Oversight Committee**.



- International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), under World Bank Group, has approved a **USD 135 million loan to West Bengal (WB)** to improve the operational efficiency and reliability of electricity supply in selected areas in the state.
- **National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Generation India Foundation (GIF)** launched a Project named **AMBER (Accelerated Mission for Better Employment and Retention)** at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi to bridge the gap between skilling and employment.
- **Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Thakur**, has announced that, **Prasar Bharati** has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with **IIT, Kanpur** to develop **Next Generation Broadcast solution for digital terrestrial broadcasting** consistent with emerging standards such as 5G broadcast.
- The **1<sup>st</sup> India Young Water Professional Programme (IYWPP)** was launched virtually today in the presence of **Mr. Manpreet Vohra, Indian High Commissioner to Australia, Barry O' Farrell, Australian High Commissioner to India** and **Ms. Debashree Mukherjee, Additional Secretary, DOWR, RD & GR, Ministry of Jal Shakti.**
- Minister of State for Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions **Dr. Jitendra Singh** today launched "unique" **Face Recognition Technology for Pensioners** in New Delhi.
- **Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate InFinity Forum**, a thought leadership Forum on FinTech, on 3rd of December via video conferencing & the event is being hosted by **International Financial Services Centres Authority** under the aegis of Government of India in collaboration with **GIFT City and Bloomberg, Indonesia, South Africa and the U.K.** are partner countries in the first edition of the Forum.

- **The Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme** for drones and drone components has been notified on 30 Sep 2021 to push the production of drones & an incentive of **Rs. 120 crores** have been provided for Indian manufacturers of drone and drone components on the basis of their value addition in India.
- As **21.52 crore loans** have been extended to women borrowers by **Member Lending Institutions (MLIs)** under the **Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY)** since inception of the Scheme.

This day is to raise awareness about people's social, cultural, and physical rights and to ensure the welfare of everyone in the world. Theme for 2021 is **'Equality – Reducing inequalities, advancing human rights'**.
- **International Mountain Day** is observed globally on **December 11** every year by The **United Nations (UN)**. **"Sustainable mountain tourism"** is the theme of International Mountain Day 2021.
- **UNICEF Day** is observed on **December 11** every year, to spread awareness on saving children's lives, defending their rights and helping them fulfill their potential from childhood to adolescence & the 2021 **Theme** is to help children to recover from interruption and learning losses experienced through the pandemic in the last two years.

- The Lok Sabha has passed the **National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (Amendment) Bill, 2021**
- Airports Authority of India (AAI) has taken up a **development programme to spend around INR 25,000 crores in next five years for expansion and modification of existing terminals.**
- To initiate infrastructure development to boost the economy after COVID-19 pandemic, Union Budget 2021-22 has provided a **capital outlay of Rs. 5.54 lakh crore, an increase of 34.5% over Budget Estimate of FY 2020-21.**
- Union Minister of State for Finance Dr Bhagwat Kisanrao Karad informed **Scheduled Commercial Banks recovered Rs 90 crore from financial frauds in last 5 years.**
- **Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0 (SBM-U 2.0)**, under the aegis of the Ministry of



Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), has launched the **Swachh Technology Challenge to Create an Innovations' Ecosystem in Waste Management**

- The **Chief Justice of India** proposed creation of a **National Judicial Infrastructure Authority of India (NJIAI)**.
- India re-elected to **International Maritime Organisation (IMO) Council** for the year **2022-2023** biennium under **category B** states.
- In an endeavour to improve the information flow and bridge the demand-supply gap in the skilled workforce market, the **Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE)** has launched '**Aatamanirbhar Skilled Employee Employer Mapping (ASEEM)**' portal to help skilled people find sustainable livelihood opportunities.
- **Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA)** scheme is benefitting the majority of farmers in overcoming the technological gaps in the industry. & **The Scheme was approved on 29th March, 2005** with an aim at centralising the management of agricultural technology transfer by making organisational arrangements and deploying innovative technologies.
- The **National Development Council (NDC)** in its **53rd meeting** held on **29th May, 2007** adopted a resolution to launch a '**National Food Security Mission**' (NFSM), was launched

in **October 2007** & the mission comprising **rice, wheat and pulses** to increase the annual production of rice by **10 million tonnes**, wheat by **8 million tonnes** and pulses by **2 million tonnes** by the end of the Eleventh Plan (2011-12).

- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** inaugurated **three mega projects** worth **₹9,600 crore** in **Gorakhpur** in **Uttar Pradesh**.
- A **Curtain Raiser Event for Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief exercise, PANEX-21**, for the member nations of **BIMSTEC** countries, was held at **Kothari Auditorium DRDO Bhawan, New Delhi** on **07 Dec 2021**.
- The **Ministry of Civil Aviation** and **Ministry of Health & Family Welfare** has mandated **contactless self-declaration at Air Suvidha Portal**, to ensure the smooth passage of international travellers arriving in India.
- **NITI Aayog Vice Chairperson Dr Rajiv Kumar**, **CEO Amitabh Kant**, **Special Secretary Dr K Rajeswara Rao**, and **Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) Director General Sunita Narain** jointly released the report titled "**Waste-wise Cities: Best practices in municipal solid waste management**," a comprehensive knowledge repository of how Indian cities are managing their solid waste.
- Parliament has passed the **Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Bill**,





2021 with the Rajya Sabha approving it. The Bill has already been passed by the Lok Sabha.

- Every year On December 17 is Observed as the International Day to End Violence against Sex Workers.
- Globally World Arabic Language Day is observed on 18 December every year with the Theme of 2021 is Arabic Language, a bridge between civilisations” reflects the role of Arabic as a connector between civilisations and its role in building peace and enhancing dialogue.
- The National Minorities Rights Day is observed in India, every year on December 18, to safeguard the Constitutionally guaranteed rights of religious minorities in the country.
- Every year, December 18, is celebrated as International Migrants Day with the theme of 'Harnessing the potential of human mobility' & the

day was designated by the General Assembly of the United Nations on December 4, 2000

- Goa Liberation Day is observed on December 19 every year in India, and it marks the day Indian armed forces freed Goa in 1961 following 450 years of Portuguese rule.
- International Human Solidarity Day, observed on December 20, is an international annual Unity Day of the United Nations and its member states

- Every year, December 22 is celebrated as **National Mathematics Day** in India in honour of mathematical genius Srinivasa Ramanujan (1887-1920).
- **National Farmer's Day or Kisan Diwas** is celebrated across the nation on **December 23** to commemorate the birth anniversary of the **5th Prime Minister of India, Chaudhary Charan Singh**.
- **Siddha day** is annually observed on **23rd December** to create awareness about the Siddha system of medicine. This year 2021 marks the **5th anniversary of National Siddha day**. The first-ever National Siddha Day was observed on **4th January 2018**.
- **December 24** is celebrated annually in India as **National Consumer Rights Day**, also called National Consumer Day, to commemorate **December 24, 1986**, when the Consumer Protection Act received assent of the President of India.
- **Good governance day** is observed annually on **December 25** & the day is also celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of India's former Prime Minister, Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

- The United Nations's International Day of Epidemic Preparedness is observed on 27th December to create awareness about the importance of the prevention of, preparedness for and partnership against epidemics.
