- Every year World Backup Day 2022 is celebrated on 31 March.
- The Transgender Day of Visibility (TDOV) is an international awareness day is observed on March 31, honouring transgender and gender nonconforming people's achievements and resilience.
- The International Day of Drug Checking is celebrated on 31st March every year since 2017.
- The foundation day of Odisha, known as Odisha Day, or Utkal Diwas will be observed on 1st April.
- International Children's Book Day (ICBD) is organised every year on April 2 since 1967, by the International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY) - an international non-profit organisation.
- World Autism Awareness Day is observed on April 2, every year to make people understand and accept people with autism, foster worldwide support, and inspire people.
- National Maritime Day is annually observed on April 5, 2022.
- The General Assembly of the United Nations agreed in 2019 to declare April 5th the International Day of Conscience, with the aim of creating conditions of stability and well-being and relationships based on respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms for all, without distinction based on race, sex, language or religion.
- The International Day of Sport for Development and Peace (IDSDP), which takes place annually on 6 April, presents an opportunity to recognize the positive role sport and physical activity play in communities and in people's lives across the globe.

- World Homeopathy Day is observed annually on April 10 to commemorate Dr Samuel Hahnemann's birth anniversary.
- The United Nations (UN) celebrates the International Day of Human Space Flight on April 12 each year.

- National Safe Motherhood Day is observed every year on April 11.
- World Parkinson's Day belongs to the Parkinson's community.
