Odisha Foundation Day 2023: April 1

- On April 1st, 2023, Utkal Diwas or Odisha Foundation Day is celebrated all over the state of Odisha, India.

- The theme of the National Safe Motherhood Day 2023 is "Remain at home amid coronavirus, protect mother and infant from coronavirus".
- The National Safe Motherhood Day was first proposed by (WRAI) White Ribbon Alliance.

Jallianwala Bagh Massacre 2023: April 13

- Every year April 13th is observed as Jallianwala Bagh Massacre.
- Jallianwalla also called as Massacre of Amritsar incident on April 13, 1919, in which British troops
 fired on a large crowd of unarmed Indians in an open space known as the Jallianwala Bagh
 Massacre in the Punjab region of India.
- The people gathered at Jallianwala Bagh to protest against the arrest of the two nationalist leaders
 Satya Pal and Dr. Saifuddin Kitchlew on 13th April 1919.

World Hemophilia Day 2023: April 17

- World Hemophilia Day is celebrated on April 17th every year.
- The theme of World Hemophilia Day is "Access for All: Prevention of Bleeds as the global standard of care".
- World Hemophilia Day was first started in 1989 by the World Federation of Hemophilia

World Heritage Day 2023: April 18

 Every year April 18th is celebrated as World Heritage Day or International day for monuments and sites.

National Civil Service Day 2023: April 21

- Every year April 21st is celebrated as National Civil Service Day.
- The first such function was held in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on 21st April 2006.

Earth Day 2023: April 22

- Every year April 22nd is celebrated as Earth Day for the past fifty-four years it has been celebrated by billions of people around the globe.
- The Earth Day 2023 theme is "Invest in our planet".
- Earth Day is first celebrated in 1969 when a US senator named Gaylord Nelson witnessed the effects
 of a massive oil spill in Santa Barbara, CA.
- He called to action on all Americans to take a stand for the environment in 1970 and thousands of colleges and universities across the United Nations organized protests for a healthy sustainable Earth.
- In 1968 the US Public Health Service organized the Human Ecology Symposium the event invited students to come and listen to scientists talking about the impact of the deteriorating environment on human health.
- In 1972 the US government formed the Environmental protection Agency and passed the Clean Air Act.
- In 1990 Earth Day went global with more than 140 countries participating in the event.
- In 1995 Nelson the man behind the Earth Day movement was awarded the Presidental Medal of Freedom.

World Book and Copyright Day: April 23

- Every year World Book and Copyright Day is celebrated on April 23 and it is also known as World Book Day.
- The theme for World Book Day 2023 is "Indigenous Languages."
- The theme is focused on the native languages of a country.
- The day is celebrated by United Nations, Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organizations and other related organizations across the world to honor authors, books, and to promote the art of reading etc...
- United Nations, Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organizations has selected 23rd April as World Book Day to pay tribute to great literary figures including William Shakespeare, Miguel Cervantes, and Inca Garcilaso de la Vega who died this day.
- In 1995 this date was finalised by the United Nations, Educational, Scientific and Cultural
 Organizations general conference, held in pairs, to pay tribute and honour authors and books
 worldwide.
- Idea to celebrated a day of books came originally the Catalans day of books called as Dia del Llibere.
- Dia del Llibere was celebrated in Catalonia every year on April 23.

National Panchayati Raj Day: April 24

- In India, 24th April is designated as National Panchayati Raj Day.
- The day is held to remember the passing of the 73rd Amendment to the Constitution on June 17,
 1992, and on April 24, 1993, the law went into force.
- Prime Minister Manmohan Singh designated the first National Panchayati Raj Day on April 24, 2010.
- The constitution of the 73rd Amendment act of 1992 that came into force with effect on April 24, 1993,
 has vested constitutional status on Panchayati Raj Institutions.
- This marks the moment in the history of decentralization of political power to the grassroots level.
- As a result, it was determined to delegate democracy's authority.
- For this reason, a panel headed by Balwantrai Mehta was established in 1957 to meet the demand.
- And for the first moment in decades, Panchayati Raj was established in India.

World Malaria Day 2022: April 25

• World Malaria Day is observed on April 25 all over the world.

- World Malaria Day will reinforce the Global Fund Investment (GFI) using the theme advance quality, building resilience, and ending malaria.
- That effort is echoed in this year's theme: "Time to deliver zero malaria: invest, innovate, implement."
- World Malaria Day which was first held in 2008 developed from Africa Malaria Day an event that had been observed since 2001 by African governments.
- The observance served as a time to assess progress towards goals aimed at controlling malaria and reducing its mortality in African countries.
- In 2007 at the 60th session of the World Health Assembly by the World Health Organization it was
 proposed that Africa Malaria day be changed to World Malaria Day to recognize the existence of
 malaria in countries worldwide and to bring greater awareness to the global fight against the malaria
 disease

World Intellectual Property Day 2023: April 26

- Every year April 26 is celebrated as World Intellectual Property Day to learn about the role that intellectual property rights play in encouraging innovation and creativity.
- The theme of World Intellectual Property Day is "Women and IP: Accelerating Innovation and Creativity".
- World Intellectual Property Day was launched in the year 2000 by the World Intellectual Property
 organization to promote and protect creative ideas, including music, art, trademarks, writings, and
 inventions.
- The official date of World Intellectual Property Day is April 26 but events are held all over the world throughout the springtime.
- World Intellectual Property Day is celebrated all over the globe in the form of panels, receptions, expos, and educational outreach for students of all ages.

International Dance Day 2023: April 29

- Every year April 29th is celebrated as International Dance Day also known as World Dance Day.
- International Dance Day or World Dance Day celebration for those who can see the value and importance of dance.
- International Dance Day or World Dance Day is celebrated through promotion by the International Dance Council.
- The day was first introduced in 1982 by the International Dance Committee of the United Nations
