World Milk Day 2025: June 1

- On June 1st of this current year World Milk Day 2025 is observed all over the world.
- It is a global event celebrated all over the world annually on June 1st every year to celebrate the dairy industry and recognize milk as a globally important food.

• This year, the theme for World Milk Day 2025 is: "Let's Celebrate the Power of Dairy."

Global Parents Day 2025: June 1

- It is a global awareness event observed all over the world annually on June 1st every year to honour parents across the world.

International Day for the Fight against IUU Fishing 2025– June 5

 Observed on June 5, the International Day for the Fight against Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated (IUU) Fishing—led by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) highlights the need to protect marine biodiversity, safeguard fisheries, and support the livelihoods of millions dependent on sustainable ocean resources.

World Pest Day 2025: June 6

- The Global Pest Management Coalition (GPMC) announced that World Pest Day will be observed on June 6, 2025.
- Since its establishment in 2017, this day has grown into a significant global event aimed at raising awareness about the crucial role of pest management in safeguarding public health, food security, and the environment.
- Theme for 2025: "Guardians of Health: Professional Pest Management for a Safer World"

World Brain Tumour Day 2025: June 8

- World Brain Tumour Day, observed on June 8, focuses on raising awareness about brain tumours, promoting early diagnosis, and supporting patients and their families.
- In 2025, it falls on Sunday, June 8, when global events—such as health talks and campaigns—will highlight challenges faced by those affected and emphasize the need for improved treatment and research.

World Food Safety Day 2025: June 7

- World Food Safety Day, observed on June 7, promotes awareness about the importance of safe and hygienic food in supporting public health and sustainable development.
- The 2025 theme, "Food Safety: Science in Action," focuses on leveraging scientific research, innovation, and modern technology to strengthen food safety systems globally.

World Oceans Day 2025: June 8



- Every year on **June 8th**, **World Ocean Day** is commemorated to raise awareness of the ocean's vital role in human life and ways to conserve it across the world.
- The 2025 **theme**, **"Wonder: Sustaining What Sustains Us"**, is a powerful reminder: the ocean not only sustains us materially—through food, energy, and trade—but also inspires, connects, and nurtures us.
- In 2008 World Ocean Day was officially created by the United Nations General Assembly to be observed yearly on June 8 to address ocean issues and conserve ocean water.

World Antiphospholipid Antibody Syndrome (APS) Day

- June 9th is World Antiphospholipid Antibody Syndrome (APS) Awareness Day is observed.
- Antiphospholipid Antibody Syndrome (APS) is an autoimmune disorder where the immune system attacks normal blood proteins.
- This causes an increased risk of dangerous **blood clots** in veins and arteries, which can lead to:
 - Deep vein thrombosis (DVT)
 - Strokes
 - Pregnancy complications, including recurrent miscarriages
 - First observed on June 9, 2010.

International Day of Play: June 11

- The International Day of Play is observed every year on June 11, this day calls upon individuals, communities, and governments to protect, encourage, and prioritize play across all stages of life.
- Theme for 2025 "Choose Play Every Day": The 2025 theme serves as a strong reminder to integrate play into daily life, emphasizing that play is not just for children, but a necessity for all ages.
- UN Recognition: Play is protected under Article 31 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (1989), affirming every child's right to leisure and recreational activity.

World Day Against Child Labour 2025: June 12

- World Day Against Child Labour 2025 is observed all over the world on June 12th as an awareness event to protect children against labour.
- Theme of World Day Against Child Labor-2025: Progress is evident, but there is more work to be done: Let's accelerate efforts!

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 In 2002, the World Day Against Child Labor was founded by the International Labour Organization (ILO), the United Nations entity that oversees the worldwide community of labour.

International Albinism Awareness Day 2025: June 13

- International Albinism Awareness Day 2025 is observed around the world on June 13 every year.
- This Day was organized by the United Nations to battle discrimination against those diagnosed with albinism and to create a society that is aware.
- The theme for International Albinism Awareness Day 2025, observed on June 13th, is "Demanding Our Rights: Protect Our Skin, Preserve Our Lives".

World Blood Donor Day 2025: June 14

- On June 14th every year, World Blood Donor Day is observed all over the world as an awareness event to raise awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products and to thank voluntary, unpaid blood donors for their life-saving gifts of blood.
- World Blood Donor Day 2025 Theme: This year, 2025, the World Blood Donor Day theme is "Give blood, give hope: together we save lives".
- In May 2005, World Blood Donor Day is created and implemented at the 58th World Health Assembly.

World Hydrography Day 2025: June 21

- Every year on June 21st, World Hydrography Day is commemorated to promote awareness about the importance of hydrography, safe navigation, and maritime environmental conservation.
- The theme this year is "Seabed Mapping: Enabling Ocean Action".
- In 2005, the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution calling for the International Hydrographic Organization to commemorate World Hydrography Day on June 21st.
- The international commemoration of **World Hydrography Day** began in **2006**.

International Yoga Day 2025: June 21

- Every year on **the 21st of June**, **International Yoga Day** is commemorated to create awareness about the relevance and advantages of yoga in everyone's life.
- The 2025 theme, "Yoga for One Earth, One Health,"
- On June 21, 2015, the first International Yoga Day was observed all around the world.

World Music Day 2025: June 21

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- On June 21, World Music Day, also known as the Fete de la Musique in French, is then observed.
- The theme for World Music Day 2025 is "Healing Through Harmony".
- Fête de la Musique was held in Paris in 1982 to commemorate World Music Day. This day was arranged by two members of the French Minister of Culture, Jack Lang, a French politician, and Maurice Fleuret, a composer, music journalist, radio producer, and arts administrator.

Global Wind Day 2025: June 15

- Global Wind Day 2025 is observed all over the world on 15th June.
- On June 15, Global Wind Day, also known as World Wind Day, is commemorated. It's a day for learning about wind energy, and its potential for reshaping energy systems, decarbonizing economies, and boosting employment and growth.
- In 2007, The European Wind Energy Association (EWEA) organized the first Wind Day.

World Elder Abuse Awareness Day 2025: June 15

- On June 15th, every year the world commemorates World Elder Abuse Awareness Day.
- 2025 Theme: Addressing Abuse of Older Adults in Long Term Care Facilities: Through Data and Action
- The day was officially recognized by the United Nations General Assembly in December 2011 bypassing the resolution 66/127 of the United Nations following a request by the International Network for the Prevention of Elder Abuse (INPEA), which first established the commemoration in June 2006.

World Fathers' Day 2025: June 15

- On June 15th, 2025, World Fathers' Day 2025 is celebrated all over the world to acknowledge and appreciate the role of fathers who play a very important role in our families, and in society at large.
- World Fathers' Day is celebrated globally on the 3rd Sunday of June every year.
- Father's Day always falls on the third Sunday in June which means its actual date changes from year to year.

World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought 2025: June 17

 Every year on June 17th, World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought is commemorated to increase public awareness about the critical need to combat desertification and drought.

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- On January 30, 1995, the United Nations General Assembly declared June 17th as World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought.
- This day has been **observed every year since 1995** to raise public awareness about the importance of reaching land degradation neutrality across the world.

World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought Observed Every Year on June 17

- World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought is observed annually on 17 June to raise awareness on land degradation and promote sustainable land management.
- It was established by the United Nations General Assembly in 1994 after adopting the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD).
- The **2025 theme** is **"Restore the Land. Unlock the Opportunities."**, emphasizing the need to restore **1.5 billion hectares** of degraded land by **2030**.

Global Observance of International Day for Countering Hate Speech

- On **18 June**, the world observes the **International Day for Countering Hate Speech**, renewing commitments to combat the spread of **online hate** and protect vulnerable communities.
- UN Frameworks: The UN Strategy and Plan of Action on Hate Speech (2019) and the 2021 GA resolution on "Promoting inter-religious and intercultural dialogue" call for a multistakeholder approach involving governments, tech firms, civil society, educators, and faith leaders.
- #NoToHate Campaign: Encourages individual responsibility—speaking out in workplaces, schools, and online—to prevent hate from normalizing and to foster a culture of respect and inclusion.

International Day of Family Remittances 2025 — June 16

- The International Day of Family Remittances (IDFR) is observed annually on June 16 to recognize the vital financial contributions made by migrant workers who send money back home to support their families and communities.
- 2025 Theme: "Remittances financing development"
- Recognized by the **United Nations General Assembly**, the day raises awareness about how over **1 billion people** worldwide—both senders and recipients—benefit from remittance flows.
- The IDFR was initiated on June 16, 2008, by the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and the World Bank.

International Domestic Workers' Day 2025 — June 16



- International Domestic Workers' Day, observed annually on June 16, highlights the critical need for decent work, fair wages, social protection, and legal rights for millions of domestic workers worldwide — especially women and migrants.
- Origin: The day commemorates the adoption of ILO Convention 189 (C189) on June 16, 2011, which established, for the first time, international labor standards specifically for domestic workers.
- The International Trade Union Confederation (ITUC) is renewing calls for governments to ratify and fully implement:

Sustainable Gastronomy Day 2025: June 18

- Observed every year on **18 June**, **Sustainable Gastronomy Day** highlights the crucial link between food, culture, health, and environmental sustainability.
- Spearheaded by the United Nations (UN), UNESCO, and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the day encourages the global community to adopt eco-friendly and culturally respectful food practices.
- In 2025, Sustainable Gastronomy Week (16-22 June) will bring together young chefs to once again craft custom menus to celebrate the week, featuring the theme "Local Seeds, Local Eats".

World Sickle Cell Awareness Day 2025: June 19

- Every year on **June 19th**, **World Sickle Cell Day** is commemorated to raise awareness of the human Sickle Cell illness.
- This year, 2025, the World Sickle Disease Day theme is "Global Action, Local Impact: Empowering Communities for Effective Self-Advocacy".
- The United Nations General Assembly declared World Sickle Cell Day in 2008 to promote awareness of sickle cell illness. They also highlighted the agony and emotional devastation that a patient with the condition must endure.

• As a result, on June 19, 2009, World Sickle Cell Day was commemorated for the first time.

World Sauntering Day 2025: June 19

- On the 19th of June every year, World Sauntering Day is observed each year all over the world to encourage people to slow down and appreciate the world around them and connect with nature.
- The purpose of this day is to remind the public to slow down and enjoy their life.
- In 1979, T. Rabe established World Sauntering Day. He was the one who started this holiday in the 1970s.

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World Kidney Cancer Day: June 12

- World Kidney Cancer Day, held every year on the second Thursday of June, falls on June 12, 2025, and serves as a global platform to spotlight kidney cancer—a disease that often progresses silently.
- This year's theme, "Understanding Kidney Health," underscores the need for awareness, early detection, and risk reduction, and is championed by the International Kidney Cancer Coalition (IKCC) in over 45 countries.
- Founded in 2017 by the International Kidney Cancer Coalition (IKCC)

World Refugee Day 2025: June 20

- Every year on **June 20th**, **World Refugee Day** is commemorated to raise awareness of the plight of refugees and the difficulties they face.
- The theme of World Refugee Day 2025 is to recognize refugees all throughout the world.-"Health for All: Solidarity with refugees"
- On December 4, 2000, Resolution 55/76 ie The United Nations General Assembly decided to observe **World Refugee Day from June 2001**.

International Olympic Day 2025: June 23

- Olympic Day Run or International Olympic Day is celebrated on June 23 all around the world.
- Venezuela, Belgium, Canada, Switzerland, Portugal, Greece, Austria, the United Kingdom, and Uruguay commemorated the **first Olympic Day on June 23, 1948**.
- The National Olympic Committee picked June 23 to commemorate the International Olympic Committee's (IOC) formation on the same day in 1894.

United Nations Public Service Day 2025: June 23

- The United Nations Public Service Day is celebrated on June 23 of every year to celebrate the value and virtue of public service to the community; highlight the contribution of public service in the development process; recognize the work of public servants, and encourage young people to pursue careers in the public sector.
- 2025 theme: "Five years to 2030: Accelerating public service delivery for a sustainable future."
- By approving resolution 57/277 on **December 20, 2002**, the United Nations General Assembly declared June 23rd as United Nations Public Service Day.

International Widow's Day 2025: June 23

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- International Widow's Day is observed all over the universe each year on the 23rd of June to draw attention to widows' voices and experiences and galvanize the exceptional support they need.
- Widows had to immolate themselves on their late husband's funeral pyre before 1827. In 2005, the Loomba Foundation established International Widow's Day in honor of Loomba's mother, who became a widow on June 23, 1954.

World Humanist Day: June 21

- World Humanist Day is celebrated every year on 21 June and we've been celebrating it since the 1980s.
- World Humanist Day originated in the 1980s through efforts by members of the American Humanist Association (AHA). Initially, there was no single agreed-upon date for its celebration, with different local chapters choosing various dates significant to their communities.
- Some selected the anniversary of the International Humanist and Ethical Union (now Humanists International), while others picked different meaningful days. The goal was to establish a day when humanists worldwide could unite and celebrate their shared values.
- By the late 1980s and early 1990s, the AHA and Humanists International democratically agreed to mark a single date as World Humanist Day, aligning it with the June solstice—a time of scientific and cultural importance.

World Rainforest Day: June 22

- World Rainforest Day is observed every year on June 22 to emphasize the importance of rainforests and the urgent need to protect and conserve them.
- These rich ecosystems play a key role in maintaining climate balance, biodiversity, and global ecological health.
- Theme for 2025 Theme: "Forests and Food"
- Initiated in 2017 by the non-profit Rainforest Partnership, dedicated to protecting rainforests and supporting local communities.

International Day of Women in Diplomacy – June 24

 The International Day of Women in Diplomacy (IDWD), established by UNGA Resolution A/RES/76/269 in 2022, is observed every June 24 to recognize women's vital contributions to diplomacy and advocate for gender equality in foreign policy, peace processes, and global governance.



 2025 Theme – "Eliminating Structural Barriers to Women's Leadership in Diplomacy": Calls for institutional reforms such as gender-balanced foreign ministries, anti-harassment and mentoring programs, ambassadorial quotas, and the eradication of patriarchal norms.

World Vitiligo Day – 25 June

- Every year on 25th June, World Vitiligo Day is observed with the aim of increasing the effort for vitiligo healthcare and education and raising awareness of the social stigma and mental challenges faced by those affected by vitiligo.
- The theme for 2025 is 'Innovation for Every Skin, Powered by AI'.
- The first World Vitiligo Day was organised in 2011 by the non-profit organisations VR Foundation (USA) and VITSAF (Nigeria) and their supporters around the world with a resolution to create awareness about this unrecognised disease and its impact on the vitiligoaffected people.
- The day 25th June, was chosen by Yan Valle, CEO of "The Vitiligo Research Foundation", to commemorate the death of Michael Jackson with an idea to have a day dedicated to vitiligo awareness.

International Day against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking 2025: June 26

- Every year on June 26th, the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking is commemorated to raise awareness about the impact and negative consequences that drugs have on society.
- International Day Against Drug Abuse on 26th June 2025, with the theme "Breaking the chains: Treatment, Prevention and Recovery for All."
- On December 7, 1987, the United Nations General Assembly established June 26 as International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking. During the early twentieth century, the global epidemic of drug usage was already recognized.

International Day of Deafblindness 2025: June 27

 The International Day of Deafblindness is observed annually on June 27 to raise awareness and advocate for the rights of individuals living with deafblindness — a unique dual disability involving both hearing and visual impairments.

International Day of the Tropics 2025: June 29

 Observed annually on 29th June, the International Day of the Tropics celebrates the unique richness and global significance of tropical regions.



- As 2025 marks the 9th edition of this observance, it underscores both the opportunities and threats faced by the Tropics.
- First Observed: 29 June 2016
- Why 29 June? Commemorates the release of the first 'State of the Tropics Report' on 29 June 2014

World Asteroid Day 2025: June 30

- On June 30th, World Asteroid Day 2025 is observed as an awareness program among the public all over the world.
- This World Asteroid Day 2025 is commemorated to promote awareness about how asteroids will be used in the future, how asteroids will pave the path for future exploration, and how we can protect our planet from asteroid collisions.
- In December 2016, the United Nations General Assembly passed resolution A/RES/71/90 proclaiming June 30 as International Asteroid Day to commemorate the Tunguska impact over Siberia, Russian Federation, on June 30, 1908, and to raise awareness about the risks of asteroids on a global scale.
