International Day of Older Persons is observed on 1st October

- The International Day of Older Persons is observed every year on 1st October.
- In 1990, the United Nations General Assembly adopted resolution 45/106 and declared October
 1 as the International Day of Older Persons.
- This day was first observed on October 1, 1991.

World Vegetarian Day is observed on the 1st of October.

- World Vegetarian Day is observed on the 1st of October of every year.
- In 1977, the North American Vegetarian Society (NAVS) founded World Vegetarian Day.
- In 1978, the International Vegetarian Union endorsed the World Vegetarian Day.
- According to the North American Vegetarian Society, World Vegetarian Day was observed in order to create some awareness about the health, humanitarian, and ethical of a vegetarian lifestyle.

The International Coffee Day is observed on 1st October

- The International Coffee Day is observed on 1st October of every year.
- The theme for International Coffee Day 2025 is "Embrace Collaboration For Collective Action
 More Than Ever".
- The International Coffee Day was first declared by the International Coffee Organisation. The International Coffee Organisation was started in the year of 1963. This day was launched in Milan.
- So in 2015, the International Coffee Organisation officially announced that International
 Coffee Day is celebrated on October 1.

Gandhi Jayanti and International Day of Non-Violence 2025

- October 2 is observed as Gandhi Jayanti in India and globally as the International Day of Non-Violence, declared by the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) in June 2007.
- The day is marked by tributes at Raj Ghat in India and global events across countries
 including Belgium, USA, Spain, Serbia, Switzerland, Thailand, Kazakhstan, and the
 Netherlands.
- Origin of Satyagraha: Gandhi coined the term during his struggles against racial discrimination in South Africa (1893 onwards), advocating truth (satya) and insistence (agraha) through non-violent resistance.

World Animal Day is celebrated on 4th October



- World Animal Day is celebrated on 4th October of every year.
- The theme for World Animal Day 2025 is "Save Animals, Save the Planet!".
- World Animal Day was first organized by Heinrich Zimmermann, the German Writer on March 24, 1925, in Berlin.
- In May 1931, the International Animal Protection Congress in Florence, Italy, adopted a
 resolution accepted his proposal, and announced the 4th October as World Animal Day.

World Teachers Day is celebrated on the 5th October

- World Teachers Day or International Teachers Day is celebrated on the 5th October of every year.
- The World Teachers' Day 2025 theme is "Recasting teaching as a collaborative profession,"
- World Teachers Day was established by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in the year of 1994.
- World Teachers Day was organized on the 5th of October in order to commemorate the signing
 of the status of the teacher by UNESCO/ILO in the year of 1966.

6th October is observed as a World Cerebral Palsy.

- Every year 6th October is observed as a World Cerebral Palsy.
- The theme for World Cerebral Palsy Day in 2025 is # UniqueAndUnited.
- In 1853, Dr. John Little recognized and studied Cerebral Palsy.
- Around 1861, he presented his research to the Obstetrical Society of London and he provided the first definition of Cerebral Palsy.
- Dr. Little said that Cerebral Palsy may occur at birth due to difficult labor. Dr. Sigmund Freud was
 the first person who stated that Cerebral Palsy may be caused by abnormal development before
 birth.

World Habitat Day is observed on the first Monday of October

- World Habitat Day is observed on the first Monday of October of every year. This
 year World Habitat Day is celebrated on the 6th of October, 2025.
- The theme for World Habitat Day 2025 is "Urban Crisis Response".
- In 1985, The UN General Assembly adopted resolution 40/202 and established World Habitat Day on the first Monday of October.
- Since 1986, World Habitat Day has been celebrated on the First Monday of October of every year.

World Cotton Day is observed on 7th October



- World Cotton Day is observed on 7th October of every year.
- In 2019, The four Cotton producers namely Benin, Burkina Faso, Chad and Mali initiated the World Trade Organisation about the World Cotton Day on October 7.
- The first World Cotton Day was celebrated on 7th October 2019 and it was hosted by the World Trade Organization.

The Indian Air Force Day is celebrated on the 8th of October.

- The Indian Air Force Day is celebrated on the 8th of October of every year in India.
- The Indian Air Force was first established on the 8th October of 1932, so the Indian Air Force

- In 2008, the first Global Handwashing Day was observed.

The 15th of October will mark White Cane Safety Day.
