World Vegan Day 2025 is observed on 1st November

- World Vegan Day 2025 is observed on the 1st of November 2025.
- The 2025 World Vegan Day theme is expected to focus on "veganism and its positive impact on the planet, animals, and human health".
- The World Vegan Society was formed in 1944 by Louise Wallis. But the Name "Vegan" was first coined by Donald Watson and his wife Dorothy Morgan in the year 1944.

All Saints' Day 2025 is observed on 1st November.

- All Saints' Day 2025 is observed on the 1st of November 2025.
- All Saints' Day was first celebrated on May 13th in the year 609 A.D. Pope Boniface IV decided to celebrate All Saints' Day.
- The last part of the followers has many different celebrations for saints.
- Later Pope Gregory III in 690 A.D. combined all the celebrations into one and made November 1
 All Saints' Day. All Saints' Day is celebrated to honour the saints who were dead on that day or in that year.

World Tsunami Awareness Day 2025 is observed on 5th November

- World Tsunami Awareness Day 2025 is observed on the 5th of November 2025.
- The theme for World Tsunami Awareness Day 2025 is "Be Tsunami Ready: Invest in Tsunami
 Preparedness."
- There is a story behind World Tsunami Awareness Day celebrated on November 5. On November 5th, 1854, Hiromura a little village which is located in the western part of Japan started celebrating their Traditional Practice, the Burning of Rice Sheaves.

International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict 2025 is observed on 6th November 2025.

- The **United Nations Environmental Programme** (UNEP) has found that for over 60 years 40 percent of all internal Conflicts have been directly linked to the exploitation of Natural Resources



connecting higher value resources like Diamond, timber, gold, and oil and scarce resources like fertile land and water.

 On 5th November 2001, the UN General Assembly declared the 6th November of each year as an International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict.

National Cancer Awareness Day 2025 is observed on 7th November.

- National Cancer Awareness Day 2025 is observed on the 7th of November 2025.
- The National Cancer Awareness Day celebration was first announced by Dr.Harsh
 Vardhan, the Indian Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare in September 2014.
- In 1975 National Cancer Control Programme was started to arrange treatment facilities for cancer.

Infant Protection Day 2025 is observed on 7th November worldwide.

- Infant Protection Day 2025 is observed on the 7th of November 2025.
- The theme for Infant Protection Day 2025 is "Protecting, promoting, and developing infants."
- Infant protection is a very important task. The first three months are the crucial period for Infants.
 It develops certain skills like Hearing, Communication, and Vision.
- Europe first started a campaign to improve child health care. Europe Countries established Infant
 Protection Day in order to create awareness among the people about Child Care Services and to
 reduce the Infant Mortality Rate (IMR).

- C.V. Raman was born on 7th November 1888, in Tiruchirappalli. His father's name was

 worked in Visakhapatnam. C.V. Raman was brilliant in early school life.

- National Education Day 2025 is observed on 11th November 2025 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, India's first Education Minister.
- The observance of National Education Day was initiated by the Ministry of Human Resource
 Development (now Ministry of Education) in 2008.
- The first National Education Day was celebrated on 11th November 2008 at Vigyan Bhawan,
 New Delhi, and was inaugurated by then President Pratibha Patil.

Uttarakhand Celebrates Its Silver Jubilee on Foundation Day 2025

- November 9 marks Uttarakhand Foundation Day, commemorating the formation of India's
 27th state in the year 2000, carved out of Uttar Pradesh.
- In 2025, the state celebrates its Silver Jubilee (25 years) of formation, honouring its journey
 from a regional movement to a recognised and developed Himalayan state.
- The state was originally named Uttaranchal and was renamed Uttarakhand in 2007 to reflect its historical and cultural heritage.



 Uttarakhand Foundation Day 2025 is being celebrated as a landmark milestone, with an extended Foundation Week from 1 November to 11 November 2025, showcasing the state's progress over 25 years.

World Pneumonia Day 2025 observed on 12th November

- World Pneumonia Day 2025 was observed on 12th November to create awareness
 about Pneumonia, one of the world's deadliest yet preventable and treatable infectious
 diseases.
- World Pneumonia Day was first observed on 12th November 2009 under the "Stop
 Pneumonia" initiative led by the Global Coalition Against Child Pneumonia, which brings
 together various institutions to fight child mortality caused by respiratory infections.

World Usability Day 2025 - Observed on 13th November

- World Usability Day is observed annually on the second Thursday of November, and in 2025, it falls on 13th November.
- The day focuses on promoting user-friendly design, accessibility, and improved user
 experience (UX) across digital and physical products.
- The concept of user experience traces back to ancient Greek civilization, where
 the principle of ergonomics was applied in designing instruments and workspaces as early as
 the 5th century BC.
- The observance was established in November 2005 by the User Experience Professionals
 Association (UXPA), which was originally founded in 1991 with about 50 members.

World Kindness Day 2025 – Observed on 13th November

- World Kindness Day 2025 was observed on 13th November to promote compassion, empathy, and goodwill among individuals and communities across the globe.
- The day is celebrated by around 27 countries, including India, Brazil, Australia, Canada,
 Japan, and Italy, although it is not yet officially recognized by the United Nations (UN).
- World Kindness Day was first celebrated in 1998 during the Tokyo Conference, marking the beginning of a global effort to foster kindness and peace.

World Diabetes Day 2025 - 14th November



- World Diabetes Day 2025 is observed on 14th November every year to raise awareness about diabetes prevention, management, and care.
- The day also marks the birth anniversary of Sir Frederick G. Banting, one of the codiscoverers of insulin.
- World Diabetes Day was established in 1991 by the International Diabetes Federation
 (IDF) with support from WHO, in response to the rising health and economic burden of diabetes.

Children's Day 2025 - 14th November

- Children's Day in India 2025 is celebrated on 14th November, marking the birth anniversary
 of India's first Prime Minister, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru.
- The theme for 2025 is "For Every Child, Every Right", emphasizing the importance of ensuring every child's rights, welfare, and education.
- He was born on 14th November 1889 to a Kashmiri Brahmin family. His father was Motilal
 Nehru, and he was the eldest among four siblings.

International Day for Tolerance 2025 – Observed on 16 November

- International Day for Tolerance 2025 is observed on 16th November, promoting respect,
 acceptance, and appreciation of the diversity of cultures, expressions, and human identities.
- The idea of global tolerance gained momentum in 1993, when UNESCO initiated the observance of 1995 as "The Year for Tolerance."

International Students' Day 2025 - Observed on 17 November

- International Students' Day 2025 is observed on 17th November.
- On this day, students across universities worldwide organize events promoting the right to education, student solidarity, and multiculturalism.
- The origin of this day dates back to Nazi occupation in 1939.

National Epilepsy Day 2025 – Observed on 17 November

 National Epilepsy Day 2025 in India is observed on 17th November to raise awareness about epilepsy, a chronic brain disorder marked by repeated seizures or fits caused by sudden, excessive electrical discharges in brain neurons.



 The day was first observed by the Epilepsy Foundation of India to reduce epilepsy-related challenges and promote public understanding about the disorder.

WORLD CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE DAY 2025 OBSERVED ON 19 NOVEMBER

- World Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease Day (COPD) 2025 is observed on the third
 Wednesday of November, and this year it falls on 19 November 2025.
- COPD stands for Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease.
- The theme for 2025 is "Short of Breath, Think COPD."
- The first World COPD Day was observed in 2002.
- The event is organised annually by GOLD (Global Initiative for Chronic Obstructive Lung Disease).

INTERNATIONAL MEN'S DAY 2025 OBSERVED ON 19 NOVEMBER

- International Men's Day 2025 is observed on 19 November, with the theme "Celebrating Men and Boys", recognizing the lives, achievements, and contributions of men and boys to the nation, society, community, family, marriage, and childcare.
- The idea for a dedicated day for men was first mentioned in 1968 by John P. Harris, an
 American journalist, who pointed out the absence of a male counterpart to International Women's
 Day and highlighted the need to focus on men's health, achievements, and contributions.

WORLD TOILET DAY 2025 OBSERVED ON 19 NOVEMBER

- World Toilet Day 2025 is observed on 19 November to raise awareness and inspire action towards tackling the global sanitation crisis and achieving Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6 – Clean Water and Sanitation for All by 2030.
- The day was founded by Jack Sim, a Singaporean philanthropist, who established the World
 Toilet Organization on 19 November 2001 and declared the date as World Toilet Day.

Universal Children's Day 2025 Observed

• Universal Children's Day 2025 is observed on 20 November 2025.



- It is celebrated to create awareness of the problems children face across the globe, improve
 the welfare of all children, and promote education, health, proper care, and nourishment for
 children.
- Children's Day was first officially declared a national holiday by the Republic of Turkey in 1920 on 23 April.

World Television Day 2025 Observed on 21 November

- World Television Day 2025 is observed on 21 November to recognize the impact of television
 in shaping decision-making, drawing global attention to conflicts, peace and security issues,
 and its role in highlighting major economic and social challenges.
- The United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) instituted World Television Day to acknowledge television as a powerful medium of communication that influences public awareness and global dialogue.

National Philosophy Day 2025 Observed on 20 November

- National Philosophy Day, also known globally as World Philosophy Day, is observed every year on the third Thursday of November; in 2025, it falls on 20 November.
- The day promotes the pursuit of wisdom, critical thinking, dialogue, and open-minded discussion to address modern social and global challenges.
- Initiated by UNESCO in 2002.

Constitution Day 2025 (Law Day 2025) is observed on 26 November

- Constitution Day 2025, also known as Law Day, is observed on 26 November to mark the day
 the Constituent Assembly adopted the Constitution of India on 26 November 1949.
- The year 2025 also commemorates the 132nd birth anniversary of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, the
 Chairman of the Drafting Committee and the chief architect of the Indian Constitution.

National Milk Day observed on 26 November 2025

- National Milk Day was observed on 26 November 2025 to commemorate the birth anniversary
 of Dr. Verghese Kurien, known as the Father of the White Revolution in India.
- The day recognizes India's transformation from a milk-deficient nation to the world's largest milk producer, contributing nearly 25% of global milk production.



International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People observed on 29 November 2025

- International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People was observed on 29 November
 2025 to commemorate the United Nations General Assembly resolution of 1947, which proposed the partition of Palestine into two independent states a Jewish state and an Arab state along with a Special International Regime for Jerusalem.
- The day aims to raise global awareness about the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and highlight the struggles and challenges faced by the Palestinian people.

World AIDS Day 2025 Observed on 1st December

- World AIDS Day 2025 is observed on 1st December with the theme "Overcoming disruption, transforming the AIDS response."
- The day aims to raise awareness about AIDS, a sexually transmitted disease caused by HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus).

International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women – 25 November 2025

- The International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women is observed annually
 on 25 November to raise global awareness about violence faced by women, including rape,
 domestic abuse, and other forms of gender-based violence.
- The day also aims to highlight the true scale and reality of violence that often remains hidden or under-reported.
- In December 1999, the UN General Assembly officially designated 25 November as the
 International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women, calling for global action to
 prevent and eliminate violence against women and girls.
